What is an Animal Aid case? Our mission is to rescue sick, injured or abused, homeless cats & dogs requiring emergency treatment. If you find an injured animal, please take it to the nearest veterinary office to have it scanned for a microchip. Lacking a microchip or an owner, and the homeless cat or dog needs emergency care, ask the vet to contact us at 918-794-6688.

We also work closely with Tulsa Animal Welfare (TAW) at 918-596-8000. You may contact them if you need assistance. If the animal goes to TAW, they will contact us but we ask that you also leave a message for us so that we can follow up promptly.

Cruelty is a crime—this includes neglect. If you know of an animal being abused, you should contact the Tulsa Police Department at 918-596-9222.

We do not handle owner relinquishments or lost pets.

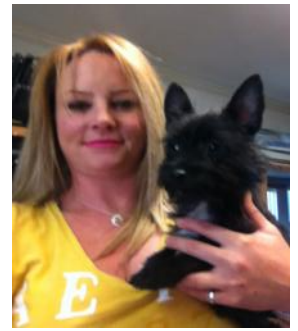

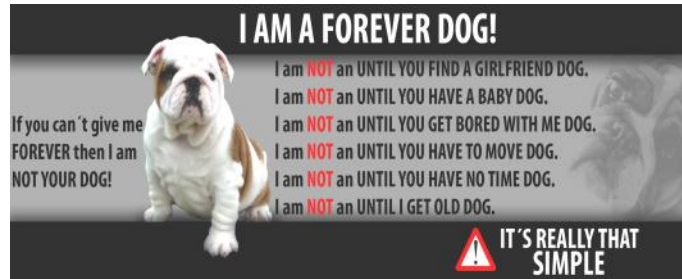
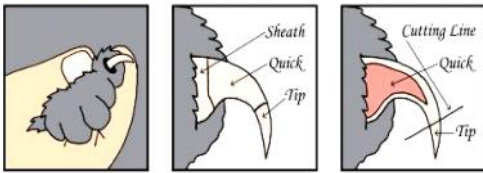

She was missing part of her diaphragm; her stomach, spleen, and colon were displaced. She also had a hernia off to the side of her diaphragm. Along with this, she was missing patches of hair here and there and suffered fractures in a couple vertebrae as well as her tail bone. One of our wonderful surgeons did his life saving magic by performing a diaphragmatic hernia surgery and an amputation of her tail. This along with lots and lots of love she has recovered tremendously!! She does show a fear of dogs. We will never know exactly what happened, but we feel it's likely possible her attacker may have been a canine. She absolutely loves other kitty cats and people!! She's a little under a year old and full of personality! Wouldn't you love to add this gorgeous girl to your family?
